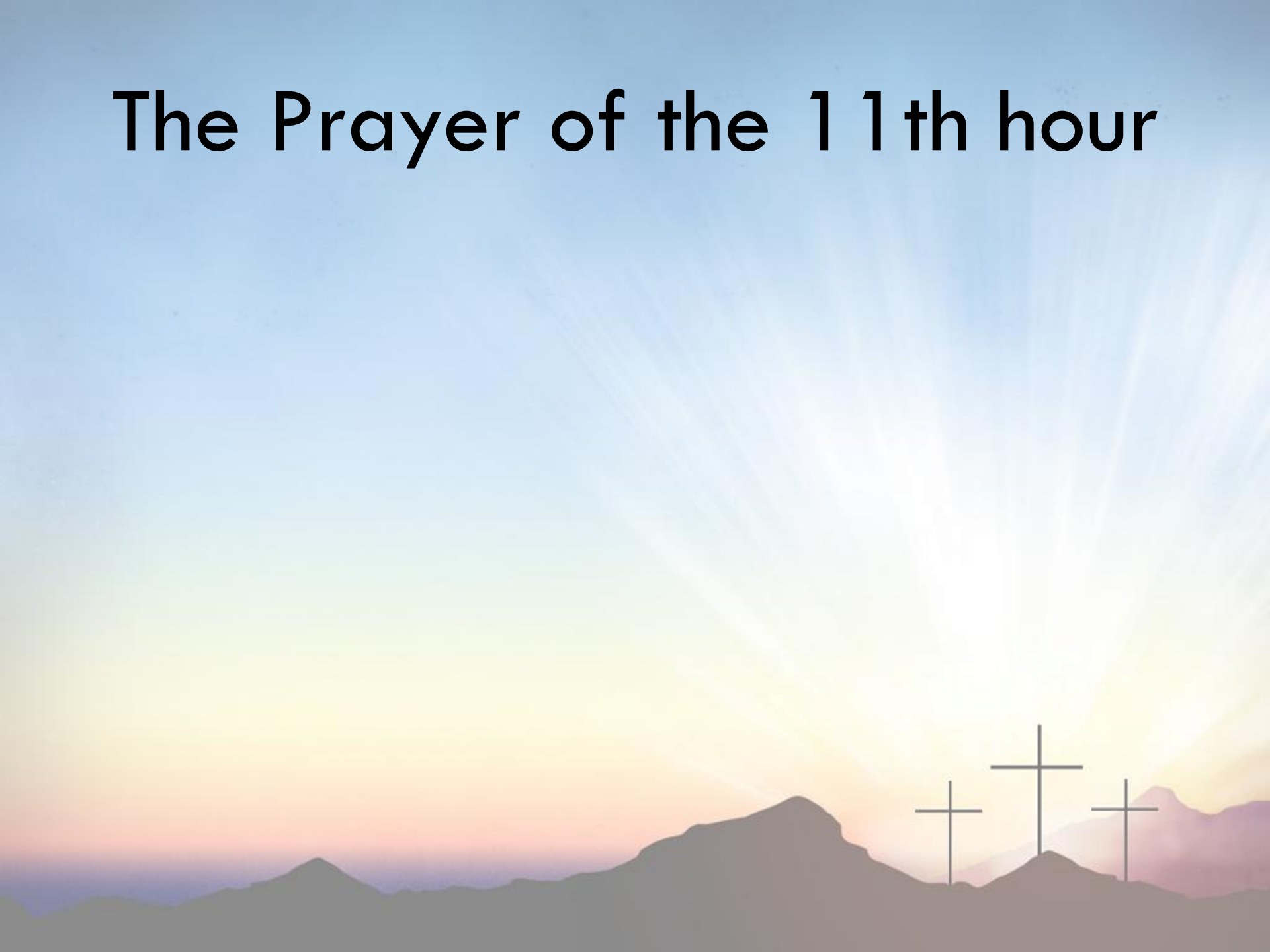

without alteration or change, holy Immortal have mercy upon us.

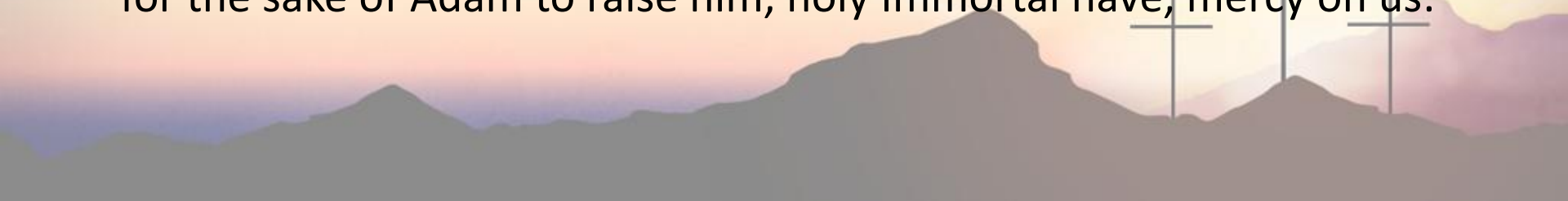
You are Jesus Christ, the Son of God the Word,
