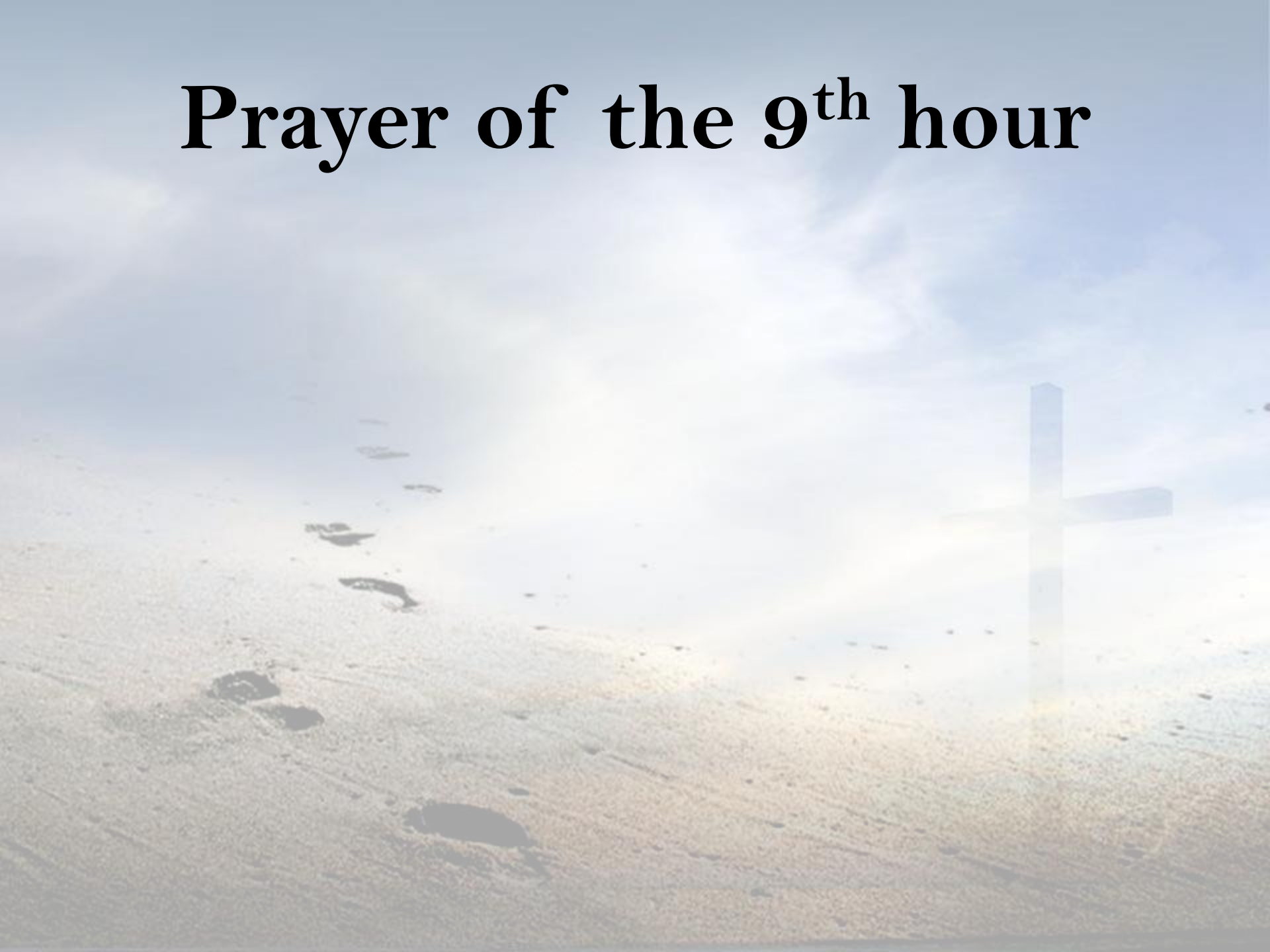




# Prayer by St. Augustine
